1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the **Action Mapping Project (AMP)** website and digital platforms (“Services”). These Terms & Conditions (“Terms”) govern your access to and use of AMP-operated websites, digital tools, teacher resources, and publicly accessible insight, maps, and indicators.

By accessing or using the Services, you agree to these Terms. If you do not agree, please do not use the Services.

AMP operates in partnership with the University of Washington Tacoma and through fiscal sponsorship arrangements that support its mission. These institutional relationships ensure continuity and stewardship but do not affect the rights or responsibilities described in these Terms.

2. WHO WE ARE

AMP transforms young people’s lived experiences into meaningful insight that we share with our partners. We are committed to protecting youth data, honoring youth voice, and providing clear and accessible insight to all who use our Services.

3. ACCEPTABLE USE OF SERVICES

You agree to use the Services in ways that align with AMP’s mission and comply with all applicable laws.

You may **not**:

- ▶ Interfere with or disrupt AMP systems.
- ▶ Use AMP data in ways that harm, profile, or target individuals or groups.
- ▶ Remove attribution from AMP-created materials.
- ▶ Scrape, bulk-download, or attempt to reconstruct individual spatial patterns from AMP outputs.
- ▶ Use AMP indicators to make claims about the behavior or character of identifiable individuals.
- ▶ Use AMP materials for surveillance or law enforcement purposes.

AMP may suspend or revoke access to the Services for misuse or behavior inconsistent with these Terms.

4. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

AMP owns all:

- Maps, indicators, graphics, curriculum, and derived insight
- Website content
- Data visualizations and analytical frameworks
- Aggregated or de-identified spatial and narrative data collected through AMP programming

Permitted Use

You may:

- View, print, or share publicly available AMP materials
- Use AMP content for educational, research, nonprofit, or community-engagement purposes
- Cite or reference AMP insight with attribution

Prohibited Use

You may not:

- Claim AMP materials as your own
- Sell or license AMP content
- Modify AMP maps, data, or indicators without permission
- Use AMP-generated data for commercial products or services

5. DATA AND PRIVACY

AMP does not collect personally identifying information from our participants.

We do not collect names, addresses, student IDs, device identifiers, or contact information through our sketch mapping or workshop tools.

AMP adheres to:

- Data minimization
- FERPA-aligned practices when partnering with schools
- Spatial data ethics grounded in youth protection
- A commitment to avoiding any data practices that could re-identify youth

Any attempt to re-identify individuals from AMP outputs is strictly prohibited.

6. ACCOUNTS (RESTRICTED TOOLS)

Some portions of the Services may require an account.

You agree to:

- Provide accurate information
- Keep login credentials confidential
- Accept responsibility for all activity under your account

AMP reserves the right to revoke access for misuse.

7. EXTERNAL LINKS

AMP Services may link to external websites or tools operated by partners or third parties. These external sites have their own policies, and AMP is not responsible for their content or practices.

8. DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTIES

AMP's Services and materials are provided "as is."

- That our indicators represent *official* (governmental) assessments of infrastructure, safety, or risk
